State Representative Christian Manuel is a native of Southeast Texas. Born in Nederland, he and his family are rooted in Port Arthur. He is the eldest of six siblings, four brothers and two sisters. Rep. Manuel's passion for politics is deeply ingrained in his life, thanks to his family's involvement and leadership in political activism. As a child, he grew up engaged in politics with the understanding of its impact on the community and state.

Representative Manuel has nearly two decades of professional experience in Texas state politics. As a veteran staffer, his role was pivotal in ensuring triumphs for the district. He started working for former State Representative Joseph Deshotel at the age of eighteen. Over time he progressed to Chief of Staff—a position he held for a decade. He gained the ability to maneuver within the complicated Texas political scene of congressmen, lobbyists, and industry experts with a sagacity that only comes with years of hard work and dedication.

In his first session as State Representative, he was recognized as Freshman of the Year by the Texas Legislative Black Caucus as he sent six bills to the Governor's desk. He successfully passed into law HB 3250/ HB 5012, which allows Beaumont to receive certain tax revenue derived from a hotel and convention center project and to pledge certain tax revenue for the payment of obligations related to the project. This legislation will boost the local economy by bringing in tourism revenue, increasing local business activity, creating job opportunities for residents, and generating tax revenue. Overall this will contribute to the development and appeal of the district, benefiting the local community while providing economic growth for Southeast Texas. Rep. Manuel has worked diligently to bring home victories for House District 22 and will continue to work tirelessly to help execute legislation for Jefferson County.

(f) The City's lien shall be inferior to a bona fide mortgage lien that is recorded prior to the date of the City's lien is recorded in the Real Property Records of Jefferson County, Texas, but shall be superior to all other liens, including previously recorded judgment liens and any liens recorded after the City's lien.

(g) The City may refuse to connect or reconnect utility services to a property on which there is a City lien for delinquent utility bills.

(h) Suit may be instituted by the city and recovery had and said liens foreclosed in the manner provided by law.

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Notice and Appeal

(h) After the filing of a lien pursuant to this Ordinance, the City Clerk shall within thirty (30) days of the filing of the lien give the owner of the property and the account holder notice that such a lien or liens have been filed on that property and inform the owner and account holder of their rights to appeal by mailing notice to the owner at the address shown on the utility account and on the Jefferson County tax roll for said property.

(i) Within thirty (30) days of the postmark of the notice sent to the property owner or account holder, the property owner or account holder may appeal the decision to impose the lien on that property to the City Council. Further, any person refused utility service by any officer or employee of the City shall have the right of appeal of that decision to City Council.

(j) The City Council or its designee shall authorize the release of the lien if the property owner or account holder shows that no bill for the above-mentioned services to the owner's property encumbered by the lien or liens is owing, or if the property owner shows that the encumbered property is and at all times, from the hour of the filing of the lien until the time of the appeal, has been a homestead as defined by the Texas Constitution.

(k) The City Council may modify or release the lien to reflect the true amount of delinquency in payment for service to the property if the owner or account holder demonstrated that a lesser bill is owing than the lien alleged.

(l) The person listed on the Jefferson County tax records as being the owner of any given piece of property shall be presumed to be the owner for purposes of this Section and the address listed for the owner of the Jefferson County tax records shall be presumed to be the address of the Owner.

Release of Lien

(m) Whenever a person or entity pays all principal, interest, and the filing fee of a lien validly filed pursuant to this Section, the Mayor or City Clerk shall execute a release of that lien and surrender it to the paying party.

(n) The City shall not be responsible for filing the release of lien.
