Hani Tohme with Golden Triangle Consulting Engineers then presented council with packets of the possible Phase II project for Lady Luck RV Resort. Mr. Tohme then went over the amenities that this RV Park would have. Mr. Tohme then informed Council that the only challenge with this project would be the sanitary sewer capacity that the area currently has. Mr. Tohme stated that after speaking with some of the City staff that staff members do not believe that the current sanitary sewer system can actually support this project's sanitary sewer. That is why Lady Luck is proposing an On-site Sewage Facilities system until the City can handle the sanitary sewer from Lady Luck then it would be switched to the City's system. This type of system is regulated by both TCEQ and Jefferson County. Mr. Tohme also informed Council that there would be no commercial or industrial waste and that it would be purely domestic waste from the RV's.

Mr. Tohme then introduced Carl and John from Bosco Industries. Mr. Carl then explained how the aerobic wastewater system works. Councilmember Konidis asked how the sludge is disposed of and Mr. Carl explained that the sludge is vacuumed out. Councilmember Dugas asked how often will the sludge have to be vacuumed out and Mr. Carl stated that it depends on usage. City Manager Kevin Carruth asked for an example of this being done similar size or larger in an urban area and Mr. Carl stated that the RV Park across from the prison but it is a spray system and not a subsurface system. Mr. Carruth then asked for an example of one with a subsurface system and Mr. Carl stated that they do not have an RV park on a subsurface system. Mayor Borne asked about the calculation of usage and Mr. Tohme stated that the designs are based on 50 gallons per day, per spot. Mr. Tohme then stated that another 30% capacity is added to that so it will still be functionable at the peak times of the day. Mayor Borne asked if all of the other specifications besides the wastewater system would be the same as Phase I and Mr. Tohme stated that was correct.

Mayor Borne asked for questions from City Council and there were none.

Mayor Borne asked for questions from the Planning and Zoning and Mr. Campese stated that this will not be an eyesore and almost everything will be below ground. Mr. Paccetti asked about the alarm and if there is anything more that could be added besides a strobe light and alarm. Mr. Tohme stated that it could be connected to a pager or phone in case someone is not on the site at the time of the alarm.

Mayor Borne then asked for property owners within 200' that wish to speak in support of the request. There were none.

Mayor Borne then asked for property owners within 200' that wish to speak against the request. There were none.

Mayor Borne then asked for any citizens of Groves that wish to speak in support of the request and there were none.

Mayor Borne then asked for any citizens of Groves that wish to speak against the request and Sidney Badon of 2310 Lackey Drive stated that when Phase I was first introduced they were told that there would be 53 units and now it will possibly be 100 units. Mr. Badon also stated he

is already having a significant amount of traffic problems and he does not think Phase II should be approved.

Building Official Don Pedraza then addressed Council stating that there is sewer hookup available for this project but the up-front cost to them to hook it up would be significant but it is available. Mr. Pedraza stated that he doesn't feel like this system should be allowed into our city because it is mostly used in rural areas. Mr. Pedraza then stated he believes they should hook up to the water/sewer system of the city. Public Works Director Troy Foxworth stated that there is a bottleneck and it will burden our system but there is the option of Lady Luck installing a lift station at their facility. Mr. Foxworth then stated that per the City Ordinance they have to plan to be able to use our system if it is available and it is available. Mr. Carruth stated that if they are within 200 ft the developer is required to the system and if the existing system can't handle the development then the burden is on the developer to improve the system to meet their needs, which is standard practice across the country. Mayor Borne asked Mr. Foxworth for a report from the City's side of it so Council can discuss this further before making any decisions. Mr. Foxworth then stated that if we allow an OSSF System for this project then that would have to allow others to do the same.

Councilmember Dugas asked if there is a danger allowing this type of system to be installed and Mr. Carruth stated as fiduciaries of the water/sewer system there is a danger in allowing this because that's how the system is expanded. Mr. Carruth also stated that the developers of the property have the duty and obligation to pay for the service to get to them if they are within 200 feet. Mayor Borne stated that there needs to be a dedicated time to really go over everything as a Council to be able to make the best decision. Mr. Tohme agrees that the ordinance needs to be looked at because it is the law of the City but he also states that Council does have the ability to modify the ordinances.

Mayor Borne then stated that no action will be taken at this meeting; the Planning and Zoning Commission will meet independently and submit a recommendation to the City Council; final determination of the request will be made at a future City Council meeting.

There were no other comments and the meeting was adjourned at 5:59 p.m.

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A regular meeting of the Groves City Council was held September 23, 2024, in the Groves City Council Chamber with Mayor Chris Borne, Mayor Pro Tem Mark McAdams, Councilmember Pete Konidis, Councilmember Rhonda Dugas, and Councilmember Paul Oliver in attendance. Mayor Borne called the meeting to order and welcomed the attendees. The prayer and pledge of allegiance was then held by the local VFW.

Mayor Borne then asked for reports and there were none. Mayor then called for citizen comments and there were none.

Mayor Borne then started the Joint Public Hearing at 5:02 p.m.

Reconvened from the Joint Public Hearing to the regularly scheduled City Council meeting at 6:00 p.m.

APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 26, 2024 AND SEPTEMBER 9, 2024 CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS: Councilmember Konidis moved to approve the minutes of the August 26, 2024 and September 9, 2024 City Council meetings. Councilmember Oliver seconded. Mayor Borne asked for discussion and there was none. Motion passed unanimously.

HEAR AND DELIBERATE ON A PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING THE 2024 GROVES PECAN FESTIVAL ROYALTY: Mayor Borne then presented the proclamations to the 2024 Groves Pecan Festival Royalty.

PRESENTATION OF RESPONSE VIDEO AND A LIFE SAVING AWARD TO DETECTIVE STEVEN BOUDREAUX IN RECOGNITION OF HIS HEROIC ACTIONS ON AUGUST 21, 2024: Interim City Marshal Christopher Robin then thanked everyone for being here to recognize the bravery and quick thinking of Detective Steven Boudreaux. Interim Marshal Robin then stated that in just a moment you will see a video demonstrating Detective Boudreaux's response to a critical incident. This is an important reminder of the impact our officers have in our community. Interim Marshal Robin then stated that on August 21, 2024, central dispatch reported an apartment fire at the Beverly Place Apartments and Detective Boudreaux who was working patrol heard the fire call and immediately reacted. The approximately 5 minute response video was then played for all to see. Interim Marshal Robin then stated that what was just observed is the definition of heroism. Detective Boudreaux acted swiftly, acted with courage when faced with chaos, and with risk to his own health and safety ultimately saved a life. Interim Marshal Robin then stated that it is his honor and privilege to present Detective Steven Boudreaux with a life saving award.

Fire Chief Lance Billeaud stated that Detective Boudreaux did a tremendous job and he appreciates it. Chief Billeaud then stated that they had a team effort that night because three different departments came together and worked as one. Chief Billeaud wanted to also present a certificate of merit to Haden Grove and Conner Stevens. Chief Billeaud stated that he has more for the firefighters that will be presented at their banquet.

DELIBERATE AND ACT ON THE SELECTION OF A PROFESSIONAL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES FIRM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS: Councilmember Konidis made a motion to deliberate and act on the selection of a professional Community Development Block Grant administrative services firm and authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute all necessary documents and Mayor Pro Tem McAdams seconded. Finance Director Lamar Ozley stated that a few months ago Council authorized a search issuing an RFP for a grant administrator related to the upcoming CDBG grant applications. Mr. Ozley then stated that the City received three different responses and one of which was ineligible because it was incomplete. Mr. Ozley then informed Council that the other two were eligible and were reviewed by a committee including himself, Public Works Director Troy Foxworth, and Mayor Chris Borne. Mr. Ozlev then stated that their findings and recommendations are in the Council packets. Mayor Borne stated that in his opinion there were two distinct differences in these firms. The first being the size of the firms and the amount of manpower that could be provided and the second was the price. Mayor Borne stated that the price was significantly lower for more manpower. Councilmember Konidis amended his previous motion to add GrantWorks as the administrative service firm based on staff's recommendation and Mayor Pro Tem McAdams seconded. There were no further questions and the motion passed unanimously.

DELIBERATE AND ACT ON AWARDING THE BID FOR THE ARPA WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, INCLUDING THE REPLACEMENT OF THE MECHANICAL BAR SCREEN AND GRIT CLASSIFIER AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS: Councilmember Dugas made a motion to deliberate and act on awarding the bid for the ARPA Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project, including the replacement of the mechanical bar screen and grit classifier and authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute all necessary documents. Councilmember Oliver seconded. City Manager Kevin

Carruth then introduced Jason Martinez from GrantWorks is here to discuss the process and give an update to where he is with this process. Mr. Carruth reminded Council that a few months ago the City was moving full steam ahead with the Wastewater project and we decided to take a step back to make sure we were following all of the federal procurement guidelines. Mr. Martinez from GrantWorks then addressed Council stating that he is the ARPA Project Manager with GrantWorks. Mr. Martinez then informed Council that he has been working with the engineer for this project and did a full review of the procurement for this bid and will continue to work with Mr. Carruth and staff. Mr. Martinez then updated Council on what has already been spent from this ARPA fund and that after this project at the Wastewater Plant is awarded and executed there will be about \$109,000 remaining. Mr. Martinez then stated that the remaining funds will need to be obligated before the end of the year. Mr. Martinez informed Council that Soutex is recommending Allco, Inc. in the amount of \$947,500 and the other bid was from MK Construction in the amount of \$997,440. Mayor Borne stated that all scopes were covered by both bidders but one was just cheaper than the other one. Councilmember Dugas asked if there is any intellectual property that is going to be involved and Mr. Martinez stated that he would have to look into that. Councilmember Dugas amended her previous motion to include awarding the bid to Allco, Inc. and Councilmember Oliver seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

DELIBERATE AND ACT ON REQUEST BY BURRITO BAR AND TORTILLA FACTORY FOR PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF AN ALCOHOL SALES PERMIT APPLICATION: Councilmember Konidis made a motion to deliberate and act on request by Burrito Bar and Tortilla Factory for preliminary approval of an alcohol sales permit application and Mayor Pro Tem McAdams seconded. Councilmember Konidis asked who is actually making the request and it is Mrs. Craven. City Manager Kevin Carruth stated that the applicant doesn't want to go through the expense of paying to get a metes and bounds survey without indication that Council will approve the application. Mr. Carruth then explained that is why the agenda item is termed as preliminary. Mr. Carruth also explained that metes and bounds is the surveyed boundaries of a piece of property. Mayor Borne asked City Attorney Brandon P. Monk if there is anything to his knowledge that would prevent a preliminary agreeance on this and Mr. Monk stated there is not. There were no further questions and the motion passed unanimously.

Fire Chief Lance Billeaud stated that they did come up with a compromise with the Firefighters Association and it will be a 5-year contract. Chief Billeaud stated they updated the pay structure and education pay. There were no further questions and the motion passed unanimously.

TxCDBG Program Overview

History

The CDBG program is governed by **Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974** (the Act) and Federal regulations at **24 CFR 570**, **Subpart I.** The introduction of the CDBG program in 1974 signaled a move away from individual categorized federal development assistance programs towards the block grant model, which gives communities broad latitude in using funds for a variety of development activities. The Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981 authorized states to administer the CDBG programs.

CDBG Objectives

The primary objective of the Community Development Block Grant program is to develop viable communities by providing decent housing and suitable living environments, and expanding economic opportunities principally for persons of low- to moderate income

To achieve these goals, the CDBG regulations outline the eligible activities and the National Objectives that each activity must meet. As a recipient of CDBG funds, the state is charged with ensuring that these HUD requirements are met. Specifically, the state is responsible for assuring the US Department of Housing and Urban Development that each project it funds meets one of three National Objectives: Benefit low-and moderate income persons; Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight; or meet a need having a particular urgency, which represents an immediate threat to the health and safety of residents.

In line with the federal objectives, the state administers its CDBG programs according to the following goals: Improve public facilities to meet basic human needs, principally for low- and moderate-income persons. Improve housing conditions, principally for persons of low- and moderate-income. Expand economic opportunities by creating or retaining jobs, principally for low- and moderate-income persons. Provide assistance and public facilities to eliminate conditions hazardous to the public health and of an emergency nature.

Primary Beneficiaries

All projects funded through the CDBG program typically meet the first national objective (benefit low- and moderate-income persons) by benefiting at least 51 percent low- to moderate-income persons, which are defined as those who earn equal to or less than 80 percent of the area median family income figure (where the area is a metropolitan statistical area or a non-metropolitan county) or Earn equal to or less than less than 80 percent of the statewide non-metropolitan median family income figure, as defined under the US Department of Housing and Urban Development Section 8 Housing Assistance Program. For income eligibility in your area, please review the most recent Income Limits document.

Some projects funded through the CDBG program may meet the second national objective of aiding in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight while the remainder of CDBG projects will fall under the third national objective. The third national objective includes activities designed to meet community development needs having a particular urgency, which the CDBG Program applies to Disaster Relief and Urgent Need Fund projects.

Program Administration

The state of Texas administers its CDBG programs in accordance to funding rules and regulations set by HUD. Each year, it submits an Action Plan for the next fiscal year. The Action Plan describes the methods that will be used for distributing funds among the various CDBG programs, including award amounts per program, application selection process, etc. On HUD approves the Action Plan it becomes codified into the Texas Administrative Code.

The TxCDBG program then makes applications available in accordance with each program's funding cycle. Application received for competitive funding programs are reviewed and scored using program-specific criteria and processes.

Once awards are made from the CDBG program, contracts are executed between the department and the city officials, and the grantee begins the implementation of their proposed project. To guide grantees in the implementation projects, the grantees follow the CDBG Project Implementation Manual. The Manual describes the methogrant recipient uses to administer the CDBG contract, and includes relevant forms. This document covers the process.

Funding

Every year, the US Department of Housing and Urban Development provides federal Community Development of funds directly to states, which, in turn, provide the funds to small, rural cities with populations less than 50,000, a counties that have a non-metropolitan population under 200,000 and are not eligible for direct funding from HUD.

small communities are called "non-entitlement" areas because they must apply for CDBG dollars through the Texas CDBG program. Larger cities, such as Dallas, Houston and others, receive CDBG monies directly from HUD, and are called "entitlement" areas.

Re: Texas Gas Service Rate Settlement



Upon the advice of counsel, at its September 23, 2024, meeting, the City approved an ordinance denying the proposed rate increase by Texas Gas Service Company (TGS). This denial has been or soon will be appealed to the Texas Railroad Commission, where the parties have finalized a settlement agreement. Counsel believes the settlement represents a reasonable outcome given the potential expense and risk of litigation.

Key terms of the proposed settlement include:

- 1. A revenue requirement increase of \$19.3 million, approximately 25% lower than TGS's requested \$25.6 million;
- 2. A 9.7% return on equity rather than its requested 10.25%;
- 3. No revenue allocation that allows a customer class to receive a rate decrease while other classes receive a rate increase, thereby mitigating the rate increase to residential customers; and
- 4. Significantly lower monthly customer charges.

Customers in the Small Residential Class can expect a \$1.84 increase to their monthly bill under the proposed settlement.

Texas Railroad Commission staff and the other intervening city coalition group have either agreed or are unopposed to the settlement terms. Hence, the probability of achieving better terms is not likely.

Staff recommends that the Council adopt the proposed ordinance, as presented.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-24

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF GROVES, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SETTLEMENT OF TEXAS GAS SERVICE COMPANY, A DIVISION OF ONE GAS, INC.'S STATEMENT OF INTENT TO INCREASE RATES WITHIN THE CENTRAL-GULF SERVICE AREA, FILED ON JUNE 3, 2024; FINDING THAT THE MEETING COMPLIES WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT; MAKING OTHER FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on or about June 3, 2024, Texas Gas Service Company, a Division of ONE Gas, Inc. ("TGS" or "Company") filed a Statement of Intent with the City of Groves ("City") and concurrently with the Railroad Commission of Texas ("Railroad Commission") to increase gas rates within the Central-Gulf Service Area; and

WHEREAS, in its Statement of Intent, TGS proposed to increase its revenue requirement by \$25.6 million per year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Groves joined the Steering Committee of Cities to intervene and participate in the Railroad Commission proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the City denied the Company's rate request and the Company appealed or will appeal the City's rate denial ordinance to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, TGS, Railroad Commission Staff, and other intervening parties including the Steering Committee of Cities participated in settlement discussions to resolve all contested rate case issues without litigation; and

WHEREAS, TGS agreed to settle the rate request at an overall rate increase level of \$19.3 million per year for the Central-Gulf Service Area combined; and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission Staff, the Lawton Law Firm, and counsel for other cities participating in this proceeding have recommended approval of the Settlement terms as a reasonable alternative to resolve all contested rate case issues without the need for prolonged litigation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVES, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The statement and findings set out in the preamble to this Ordinance are hereby in all things approved and adopted.
- Section 2. The City of Groves hereby authorizes the settlement of the TGS rate case proceeding at an overall rate increase level of \$19.3 million per year.

Section 3. The meeting at which this Ordinance was approved was in all things conducted in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage.

GROVES ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

CORPORATE BYLAWS

These Bylaws (referred to as the "Bylaws") govern the affairs of the Groves Economic Development Corporation, a public instrumentality and a non-profit corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") created under Section 4B of the Development Corporation Act of 1979, Article 5190.6 of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas (hereinafter referred to as the "Act").

Article I. Purpose

1.01. The Corporation is organized exclusively for the purpose of benefitting and accomplishing public purposes of the City of Groves, Texas, by promoting, assisting and enhancing economic development activities for the City as provided by the Development Corporation Act of 1979, Texas Revised Civil Statutes Annotated Article 5190.6, as amended. The Corporation has no members and is a non-stock corporation.

Article II. Registered Office and Agent

2.01. The registered office of the Corporation shall be maintained in the City of Groves, Jefferson County, Texas, where the Corporation shall maintain a registered office and the registered agent as provided in the Act. The Board of Directors shall be authorized to establish additional offices as well, and to change the location of any office of the Corporation.

Article III. Board of Directors

Management of the Corporation and General Powers

- 3.01. The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors appointed by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Groves. All voting rights shall be vested solely in the Board, whose members shall serve without compensation. In addition to the powers and authorities expressly conferred upon them by these Bylaws, the Board of Directors may exercise all such powers of the Corporation and do all lawful acts and things as are not prohibited by statute or by the Charter or by these Bylaws. Without prejudice to such general powers and other powers conferred by statute, by the Charter and by these Bylaws, it is expressly declared that the Board of Directors shall have the following powers, to-wit:
- (i) To purchase, or otherwise acquire for the Corporation, any property, rights, or privileges which the Corporation is authorized to acquire, at such price or consideration and generally on such terms and conditions as they think fit; and at their discretion to pay therefore either wholly or partly in money,

And about

stock, bonds, debentures, or other securities of the Corporation as may be lawful.

- (ii) To create, make and issue notes, mortgages, bonds, deeds of trust, trust agreements and negotiable or transferable instruments and securities, secured by mortgage or deed of trust on any real property of the Corporation or otherwise, and to do every other act or thing necessary to effect the same.
- (iii) To sell or lease the real or personal property of the Corporation on such terms as the Board may see fit and to execute all deeds, leases and other conveyances or contracts that may be necessary for carrying out the purposes of this Corporation.
- (iv) To do all things and take all action authorized by Article 5190.6, as amended.
- 3.02. The Board shall be composed of seven (7) Directors who shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council. Directors will be selected based on the following:
- (i) interest in the work of the Corporation, special expertise and civic service; (ii) at least three (3) of the Directors shall not be employees, officers or members of the governing body of the City of Groves; (iii) at least one (1) Director from each of the four (4) City Wards; and (iv) all Directors shall be residents of the City of Groves.

Terms of Office

3.03. The term of office shall be two (2) years or until successors are appointed.

Vacancies

3.04. Any vacancy occurring in the Board of Directors will be filled by appointment of the City Council of Groves. The vacancy will be filled for the unexpired term of the Director.

Board Attendance

3.05. Unless special consideration is granted by the Board to accommodate directors who are temporarily inactive for good cause, any director who is absent from three (3) consecutive regular or special meetings of the Board may be asked to resign. The Board's decision not to ask for the Director's resignation shall not negate the City Council's authority to do so.

Council Decorum and Procedures Policy

Approved by the City Council on January 28, 2002

Section 5. Presiding Officer

- a. The Mayor shall be the presiding officer at all meetings of the City Council, and shall be recognized as the head of the City for all ceremonial purposes.
- b. In case of the Mayor's absence or temporary disability, the Mayor Pro Tem shall act in his behalf.

Section 6. Council Standards

- a. Public officials are agents of the public, and hold office for the benefit of the public. Each member of the City Council is bound to uphold the Constitution of the United States and of the State of Texas, to carry out applicable laws and the provisions of the City Charter and Ordinances of the City of Groves on a impartial basis.
- b. Each elected official is bound to observe in his/her official acts the highest standards of morality, and to discharge faithfully the duties of the office regardless of personal considerations, recognizing that the public interest must be their primary concern.
- c. Councilmembers should be independent, impartial and responsible to the citizens, and public office shall not be used for personal gain.
- d. The conduct of each member in both their official and private affairs should be above reproach.
- e. Councilmembers must represent unconflicted loyalty to the interests of the citizens of the entire City. This accountability supercedes any conflicting loyalty such as that to their ward or any other ward, any advocacy or special interest group, or any individual, or membership of (or affiliation with) any company or other private or public organization.

Section 7. Council Etiquette

- a. Councilmembers are to provide advance notice to the City Manager's office in advance of an impending absence, unless the absence is attributable to a sudden unanticipated event. This information is necessary in order for staff to determine in advance whether a quorum will be available for a meeting.
- b. Councilmembers are expected to attend all regularly scheduled Council Meetings, Work Sessions and Executive Sessions, and to be in their seats by the time that the meeting is scheduled to start.
 - c. Speaking in Council meetings is prohibited except when recognized by the Mayor.
- d. The Mayor shall be addressed as "Mayor (Surname)", "Your Honor", or "Mr./Madam Mayor". The Mayor Pro Tem and other Councilmembers shall be addressed as "Mayor Pro Tem (Surname)" or "Councilmember (Surname)".
 - e. Speaking over others or interrupting while others have the floor is not permitted.
 - f. Cell phones and pagers should be turned off or to vibrate during meetings.
- g. If Councilmembers must take a call during a meeting, the call should be taken outside of the meeting room so as to not distract from the proceedings of the meeting.
